*Liborio Parrino was born in New York (USA) December 3, 1954. He is Associate Professor, Director of the School of Specialization in Neurology and Director of the Sleep Disorders Center, Department of Neuroscience, University of Parma. He lectures on the postgraduate course of Neurology and the lessons assigned in the Degree in Medicine and Surgery. He also teaches Neurology at the Degree Courses in Physiotherapy, Ortopotic and Audioprothetic Techniques at Parma University.*

*He was elected President of the Italian Association of Sleep Medicine (AIMS) in 2012, Assistant Treasurer of the WASM Governing Council in 2013, and Chair of the Executive Committee of European Assembly of National Sleep Societies (ANSS) in 2014. Since 2013 he is member of the Ethical Committee of the Parma Hospital, Health and University Service. Founding member of the World Association of Sleep Medicine (WASM). Co-Chair of the World Sleep Day, organized annually by the WASM since 2008. Past Chief-Editor of the WASM Newsletter. Member of the Editorial Board of scientific journals SLEEP DISORDERS and SLEEP MEDICINE.*

*Over the years he has been invited in Europe, Asia, Africa and the United States to chair workshops and present lectures. Since August 2009, became a member of the board of experts for the preparation of MedLink Neurology Clinical Reports. He signed numerous scientific publications (112 on Pubmed), articles and monographs on sleep medicine with a H-index of 38. As a reviewer he has evaluated more than 190 manuscripts submitted for publication in SLEEP MEDICINE and in other journals of clinical neurophysiology and sleep (SLEEP, JOURNAL OF CLINICAL SLEEP MEDICINE, JOURNAL OF SLEEP RESEARCH, EPILEPSY, BIOLOGICAL PSYCHIATRY, CLINICAL NEUROPHYSIOLOGY, INTERNATIONAL CLINICAL PSYCHOPHARMACOLOGY, SLEEP MEDICINE REVIEWS).*
