

Nicola Scichilone is currently Associate Professor in Respiratory Diseases of the Department of Biomedicine and Specialist Medicine, University of Palermo, Italy, and Adjunct Associate Professor of the Department of Environmental Health Science of the Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, USA. Dr. Scichilone is active staff of the “V. Cervello” Hospital in Palermo, where he is head of the Outpatient Clinics of Allergy and of Asthma and Respiratory Diseases. He graduated cum laude in 1992 at the School of Medicine, University of Palermo and participated to the Residence Programme in Respiratory Diseases in the period 1994-1998 at the same University. From 1998 to 2001, Dr. Scichilone was a post-doctoral research fellow at the Asthma and Allergy Center of the Division of Allergy and Immunology of the Johns Hopkins University in Baltimore, and since then, he has maintained active scientific collaborations with the Institution, as a consultant for NIH grants at the Johns Hopkins University. Dr. Scichilone obtained his Ph.D on Respiratory Physiopathology at the University of Parma, Italy in 2004. He is principal investigator in clinical studies performed at the Department of Biomedicine and Specialistic Medicine in Palermo, and his main research interests are the pathogenesis of airway hyperresponsiveness and the clinical aspects of asthma and COPD. Dr. Scichilone has an excellent experience in clinical trials according to Good Clinical Practice. He is heavily engaged in teaching activities for the School of Medicine in Palermo, where he teaches Respiratory Diseases. He is member of the European Respiratory Society, the Italian Society of the Aerobiology, the Italian Respiratory Society, the Italian Society of Allergy, Asthma and Immunology, and the Italian Society of Respiratory Diseases in Geriatric Age. He is author of more than one-hundred peer-reviewed publications and co-author of several book chapters and monographs.
